Curbside Recycling in Gretna

Curbside recycling will continue in Gretna (70053 & 70056 Timberlane), and Waste Connections has informed us there are no longer plans to discontinue the service. It has been our priority to resume curbside recycling and we are happy that the City of Gretna is able to do so.

Please remember that everything in your bin(s) MUST be clean. Materials in your bin(s) must be loose, not stuffed into one another. If done so, this will lead to contamination. Please do not put items into plastic bags as they are not accepted. Additionally, please remove newspapers from plastic delivery bags. Please review the list of items accepted and not accepted.

Items accepted

Paper products, corrugated cardboard and boxboards
Steel and ferrous, metal food containers and lids, aluminum cans
Plastics – coded 1 through 3: soft drink bottles, water bottles, sports drink bottles, peanut butter jars, mouthwash bottles, salad dressing bottles, condiment bottles, liquid dish detergent bottles, shampoo bottles, any post-consumer plastic product labelled #1, milk jugs, juice bottles, vinegar bottles, some dairy tubs, bleach bottles, and any post-consumer plastic product labelled #2.

Items not accepted

Glass
Aerosol spray cans
Containers that previously held oil
Paint or pesticides
Styrofoam-like egg cartons and packaging peanuts
Plastic bags
